Please place the *chometz* to be burned in paper or a paper bag.

As a convenience, dumpsters will be provided for larger amounts of chometz. Please do not abuse this service by bringing excessive amounts of chometz or trash.

ONLY FOOD ITEMS will be accepted.

Baltimore City Residents (with ID) may bring NON FOOD ITEMS to the NORTHWEST TRANSFER STATION 5030 Reisterstown Road (corner Garrison Blvd.) between 7 a.m. – 3 p.m.

RECYCLING is encouraged - designated dumpsters available on site.

ONCE AGAIN – residents may donate their unopened food items to the food pantry of the "CHOMETZ SHARING" project jointly offered through Baltimore City Council President, Jack Young, CHAI, and Park Heights Renaissance

There is NO LIMIT to the amount of trash that a resident of Baltimore City can place OUTSIDE HIS HOME as long as it is in a can with a tight fitting lid. The regularly scheduled Trash Pick –Ups in the week before Passover will take it all.

The Mussar movement was an educational approach that developed in the 19th century in Eastern Europe, specifically amongst Orthodox Lithuanian Jews.

The Hebrew term Mussar (מוֹסֶר) means moral conduct, instruction or discipline.

The term was used by the Mussar movement to refer to efforts to further the development of an ethical and spiritual discipline amongst Jews.

RECYCLING is encouraged - designated dumpsters available on site.

NO BULK TRASH (non-food related) will be permitted.

AFTER YOUR CHOMETZ is burned, Kol Chamira is recited.

BEDIKAS CHOMETZ (Night)
