### Dvar Torah on This Week's Parsha פרשת כי תצא

In this week's Parsha we find a cluster of mitzvot that seem to be unrelated. They are שלוח הקן (sending the mother bird away before taking her young), מעקה (building a protective fence on your roof), כלאים (do not plant certain plants next to your vineyard), שעטנז (do not wear wool and linen) and the list rounds off with the commandment to wear

Rashi, who is obviously bothered with the placement of these mitzvot next to each other quotes the well known dictum "מצוה גוררת מצוה". One mitzvah leads to another.

The Maharal (1512-1609) who agrees with Rashi that this is an instance of מצוה גוררת מצוה comments that these mitzvot are actually in a very specific order. When one shows care and concern by allowing the mother bird to live and build more nests, one will merit his own "nest" that will need a house. He will merit building a fence for his house. Because he is protecting human beings, Hashem grants him material wealth and he then has the ability to acquire a field. Here the mitzvah of planting grapes separate from other plants will apply. He will, as reward for this mitzvah eventually be able to afford fine clothing and must remember not to mix wool and linen. He can put this mitzvah into practice with all his clothes including his four cornered garment, ציצית, which is also the final mitzvah in the cluster!

### The OCA Art Program

At Ohr Chadash Academy, our art students in grades one through six will embark on a journey of exploration about famous artists from classical times to modern days (our fantastic Kindergarten staff will be incorporating art into their regular program). Your children will begin by studying the unique self-portraits of thirteen different artists, starting with the first known self-portrait, to learn about the styles and interesting details that can be found in artist's work. The children will then create their own self-portraits based on their favorite masters.

In grades one and two, students will create a book about famous artists, which will contain a four line poem about each artist and the students' own creations based on what they have learned about that artist. At the end of the year, the students will take their books home.

In grades three and four, the students will study artists and will use art as an extension of topics covered in their social studies curricula, as much as possible. Students will learn to compare and contrast different pieces and will learn to appreciate the world around them in a new light. After studying each artist or artistic style, the children will make their own creations, putting their new skills to good use.

In grades five and six, we will begin our month- long units after the Tishrei *chagim* (holidays). The students will receive guided research projects that will be developed together with Mrs. Friedman and Mrs. Werdesheim that will connect with their social studies units as much as possible. As they learn about art history and the styles of famous artists, they will also hone their research skills while practicing time management for long-term projects. Once a month, we will have art class in which the students will present what they have learned with each other and will make their own creations based on their research projects.

I am very excited to be working with your children this year and look forward to updating you on their progress in our art program throughout the year in Ohr Chadashot. Watch for pictures of work made by our talented OCA students!


### The Ohr Chadash "Baby Shower"
