

Community Safety Update: Oct 2025

Keeping Our Community Safe - One Call at a Time

Throughout the month of Oct, Shomrim of Baltimore has continued to work diligently to protect our neighborhoods, support victims, and partner with local authorities to deter crime and ensure public safety.

Monthly Statistics:

Total Calls Received: 169 • Total In-Person Responses: 110 • Issues Handled by Phone: 59

Every call matters. Whether dispatched in person or resolved remotely, our team remains committed to responding with compassion, discretion, and urgency.

✓ Highlights:

- Masked Teens with BB Gun: Residents reported several masked juveniles carrying what appeared
 to be a firearm near Labyrinth and Reisterstown. Shomrim units were first on scene, secured the
 area, and coordinated with responding officers. The object was confirmed to be a BB gun, and
 police ensured the situation was de-escalated without injury.
- Missing Child: A young student was reported missing in the Light Town Court area. Within
 minutes, multiple Shomrim responders were dispatched, canvassing nearby streets and notifying
 schools and local businesses. In close coordination with police and community contacts, the
 child was located safe less than an hour later.
- Attempted Stabbing: Shomrim dispatchers received multiple reports of a masked individual
 attempting to stab a resident after being confronted during a vehicle break-in. Responding units
 arrived rapidly and secured the area while maintaining communication with Baltimore Police.
 Detectives from the precinct later confirmed that footage and descriptions provided by Shomrim
 responders were instrumental in identifying the suspect.

Notable Trends:

Rising Trend of Anti-Semitic Incidents: This month, multiple cases of targeted harassment, threatening behavior near schools and synagogues, and property damage involving religious symbols were reported across North America. These incidents are being closely monitored and relayed to appropriate law enforcement agencies. We encourage the community to keep "an eye out" as they go through their day and report any suspicious activity to the police and Shomrim of Baltimore.

Rising Trend of Thefts from Vehicles: A recurring pattern of items stolen from unlocked cars persisted. Police ask that we remind the community to move valuables from plain sight and remember to ensure cars are locked.

1 Top 3 Crime Types in October:

- 1. **Suspicious Persons / Activity:** Residents reported individuals loitering, checking car handles, or wandering near homes late at night. Many calls were resolved through proactive patrol verification or coordination with police.
- 2. **Theft / Vehicle Tampering:** Multiple incidents involved items stolen from unlocked cars or suspicious persons attempting vehicle entry. Shomrim patrols intercepted several suspects in progress, and video footage from community cameras was shared with detectives.
- 3. **Burglary / Attempted Break-Ins:** Calls involving individuals attempting to enter residences or outbuildings during overnight hours (typically between 2–6 AM). In several cases, suspects fled upon realizing they were being monitored or recorded.
