We encourage individuals not to walk alone and always be aware of their surroundings, especially in the evening and early morning hours. As many congregations hold all night learning programs we suggest you let your families know which particular congregation you are attending to prevent your family not being able to locate you. (We hope to prevent calls concerning missing persons due to communication failures.)

We are working together to take added measures to increase public safety. These measures include increased coverage by law enforcement and hired security personnel operating both the NWCP and Shomrim patrol vehicles during Shavuos.

On behalf of our community we want to sincerely thank our local law enforcement partners for not only being aware of our increased coverage needs but providing additional resources.
