Measles Vaccination Clinic

Baltimore City Health Department is offering a free measles vaccination clinic on

Tuesday, May 7, 10:30 am – 2:30 pm*
Congregation Shomrei Emunah
6221 Greenspring Avenue, Baltimore

Free vaccine will be provided to children over 1 year of age** and adults who have not yet received two doses of MMR vaccine, and are unable to receive it at their primary care physician's office or pharmacy.

Priority populations for this vaccine clinic include:

- Children and adults who are not able to access vaccine at their pediatrician's office, primary care office or pharmacy
- Individuals who are not otherwise able to afford vaccine
- Anyone who is experiencing challenges accessing MMR vaccine

If you or your child are sick, have a fever, or are feeling ill, please discuss vaccine with your primary care physician and do *not* attend the vaccine clinic.

Please bring any records of previous MMR vaccine with you to the vaccine clinic.

* As vaccine supplies permit

** Children 6–12 months may be eligible for MMR vaccine. Please discuss vaccinating children less than one year with your child's physician.
