Complete *Shachris Shemona Esrai* before 10:58 am. Note: *Shachris* is the last *Tefila* during which everyone recites *Mashiv Haruach U'morid Hagashem*. Many recite it at *Musaf* as well, yet some begin *Morid Hatal* at *Musaf* (or *Mincha*). This depends on your *minhag*.

Note: If you are making early *Shabbos*, start *Mincha* before 6:05 pm. Do not recite *Kabalas Shabbos* or *Maariv* until after the candles have been lit.
